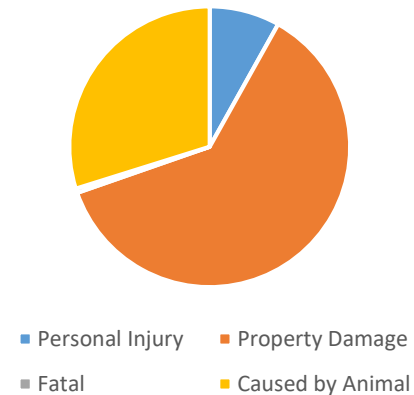

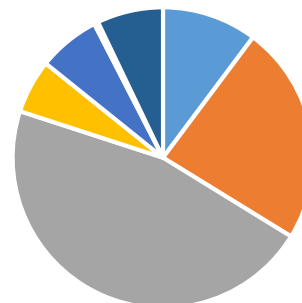

MARINE PATROL ACTIVITY

The following data is the result of deputy activity while conducting marine patrol efforts in Steuben County during the busy boater activity season. These statistics do not include activities of the DNR.

- Tickets Issued – 13
- Warnings issued – 123
- Personal Injury Boating Accident – 1 minor incident involving a swimmer
- Property Damage Boating Accident – 1
- Boater Assist – 163
 - Tows, Questions, HIN checks, etc.
- Patrol Assist – 10
 - Assisting patrol on calls of service

- Boater Class Graduates – 68

There were 125 scheduled patrols this year. Each scheduled patrol is approximately 4 hours, but may be more or less based on boat traffic or weather conditions. 18 different lakes throughout Steuben County were primarily patrolled this season.

2015 was the 4th year in a row with no major boating accidents or drownings during the busy summer boating activity season. All Marine Patrol efforts are the result of a \$25,000 grant through the Department of Natural Resources from LARE funding and local donations. The Steuben County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol effort has a strong emphasis on high visibility and boater safety education.
